



Commodore Mohammad Mozammel Haque joined Bangladesh Naval Academy as Officer Cadet on 15 April 1982. He attended basic cadet training in Bangladesh Naval Academy. On successful completion of basic training, he was commissioned in the Executive Branch in Bangladesh Navy on 15 April 1985.

Commodore Mozammel attended various professional courses both at home and abroad and obtained 1st Class in all the graded courses. He has been awarded with the “Nau Utkorsha Podak (NUP)” in 2014 For Outstanding Contribution for BN Development and has been awarded with CNS Commendation twice in 1987 & 2005 for his outstanding achievement in Anti-Smuggling Operations in Bay of Bengal.
