NOTIFICATION

Dhaka, the 5th July 1983

No. S.R.O. 247-L/83.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Ports Act, 1908 (XV of 1908), read with sub-section (2) of that section, the Government is pleased to extend the said Act to the Ports of Aricha, Nagarbari, Daulatdia and Kazirhat and to define the limits of the said Ports as under:—

Limits of the ports

I. Aricha, District Dhako

- (a) To the North—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-51'-0'N.
- (b) To the South—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-49'-0'N.
- (c) To the East—Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark at ordinary spring tides from the east bank of river Jamuna.
- (d) To the West—Up to 100 yards of river Jamuna from the east bank of the said river as it runs between the above prescribed north and south limits.

II. Nagarbari, District Pabna

- (a) To the North—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-58'-0"N.
- (b) To the South—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-56'-0"N.

- (c) To the West—Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark at ordinary spring tides from the west bank of river Jamuna.
- (d) To the East—Up to 100 yards of river Jamuna from the west bank of the said river as it runs between above prescribed north and south limits.

III. Daulatdia, District Faridpur

- (a) To the North—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-47'-0'N.
- (b) To the South—A line drawn east and west at latitude 23°-45'-30"N.
- (c) To the West—Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark at ordinary spring tides from the west bank of river Jamuna.
- (d) To the East—Up to 100 yards of river Jamuna from the west bank of the said river as it runs between above prescribed north and south limits.

IV Kazirhat, District Pabna

- (a) To the East—A line drawn north and south at longitude 89°-40'-30"E.
- (b) To the West—A line drawn north and south at longitude 89°-39'-30"E.
- (c) To the North—Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark at ordinary spring tides from the north bank of river Padma.
- (d) To the South—Up to 100 yards of river Padma from the north bank of the said river as it runs between above prescribed east and west limits.
