No. S. R. O. 373-L/81/WD/IS-16/81-221:-In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Ports Act, 1908 (XVof 1908), read with sub-section (2) of that section, the Government is pleased to extend the said Act to the Port of Baghabari and to define the limits of the said port as under:-

LIMITS OF PORT OF BAGHABARI

- **To the North:** A line drawn east and west across the river karatoa at a latitude 24° -9' -0" N.
- **To the South:** A line drawn east and west across the river Hurasagar at latitude 24°-9'-0" N.
- **To the East:-** Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark during monsoon on the east banks of the Karatoa river and Hurasagar river between latitude 24° -6′ -0″ N and latitude 24° -9′ -0″ N.
- **To the West:-** Up to 50 yards beyond high water mark during monsoon on the west banks of the Karatoa river and Hurasagar river between latitude 24°-6'-0" N and latitude 24°-9'-0" N and upto 50 yards beyond high water mark during monsoon on the north and south banks of the Baral river lying east of longitude 89°-34'-0" E.
