**NOTIFICATION**

Dacca, the 22nd November 1975.

**No. S. R. O. 388-L/75.-** In exercise of the power conferred by clause (a) of sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Ports Act, 1908 (XV of 1908), read with sub-section (2) of the said section 4, the Government is pleased to (a) extend the provisions of the said Act to the Port of Patuakhali, and (b) define the limits of the Port of Patuakhali and the navigable rivers and channels there to as under.

**PORT LIMITS**

**To the East:-**Up to 50 yards beyond The High water mark at Ordinary spring tides on the East Bank of Lohalia river between Latitude, 22° -22' N.

**To the West:-**A line drawn across Patuakhali river at Longitude 90° -18'-30" N.

**To the North:-** Up to 50 yards beyond the high water mark at ordinary spring tides on the North Bank of Patuakhali river and West Bank of Lohalia river between the lines drawn across Patuakhali river at Longitude 90° -18' -30" E and Lohalia river at 22° -22' N.

**To the South:-**Up to 50 yards form the South Bank of Patuakhali river and West Bank of Lohalia river between the lines drawn across Patuakhali river at Longitude 90° -18'-30" E and Lohalia river at Latitude 20° -21' N.
